

WHO DOES WHAT IN THE COUNCIL WORLD?



Social Care:	Adult and Child social care; respite care; residential care homes; social workers & home visits; adoption; care in the home; occupational therapists; direct payment schemes and works with the NHS to provide mental health care and hospital services.
Education:	Schools provision; attendance; truancy issues; inclusion into education for travellers; school governors, standards and funding; teaching staff and standards; lifelong learning and adult courses.
Cultural:	Libraries; archives and historical information (many councils deposit their old books/burial records etc in the LCC archives for family research); research services; educational talks and displays; heritage, museums and galleries.
Planning:	Applications relating to schools; libraries, waste recycling sites, fire stations.
Transport & Roads:	Public transport; Call Connect service; bus routes; road maintenance, road closures; new road schemes (in conj with Highways Agency for major roads); bypass schemes; traffic lights; road markings; footway maintenance; salting roads; clearing blocked road gullies; on street parking orders.
Recycling & Waste	Recycling centres (Louth/Skegness); disposal of household waste (collected by the District Council); provision of landfill (rare); clinical waste disposal; local recycling centres.
Tourism & Development:	Tourism strategy for the county; economic development
Youth:	Youth centres; youth issues; career guidance and advice; Youth Council.
Other:	Marriage licences; registrar offices; information and guidance on safety; health; abuse; street lighting; Emergency Planning (with ELDC)



Council Tax & Rates:	Collection and forwarding on to other authorities/government (Business Rates) tax and housing benefits; advice.
Economic Business:	Tourism infrastructure; advice, guidance for small businesses, economic regeneration information, health and safety.
Community:	Grants; cemeteries (where not managed by towns/parishes); crime and disorder; neighbourhood management; Local Strategic Partnership; Market Towns Initiative scheme; community planning.
Environment:	Abandoned vehicles; stray dogs; dog warden services; pest control; trees; energy efficiency schemes; food safety and hygiene; caravan site licences; routine inspections; air quality; noise; contaminated land issues; burials (where no relatives); entertainment licences & consultations; street collections licences.
Health:	Monitoring of swimming pools; animal licences; radon; drainage issues; pollution; houses in multiple occupation; food premises standards.
Housing:	Advice; grants; waiting lists (Platform Housing controls the housing stock); homelessness and support; private sector rentals.
Leisure:	Arts; festivals; management of beach huts (privately owned) ; parks and gardens; illuminations, sports events, tourism. Magna Vitae is responsible for the management and operation of leisure facilities on behalf of ELDC
Planning:	Development Control; Local Development Framework (ex. Forward Planning); Flood Risks; Strategy documents; conservation issues (listed buildings/conservation areas); Government guidance and policy; Lincs Building Consultancy (ex. Building Control) who also deal with dangerous structures; enforcement of planning.
Refuse:	Wheelie bins; recycling; collection of waste; bulky refuse collection; fly tipping. (note – collects and transports all household waste to LCC)
Other:	Street sweeping and cleaning; maintenance; gardens; planting schemes; emergency planning (with LCC); beach cleaning; some streetlights; car parks; premises and venues; Sports Halls; parks & recreation grounds; CCTV central control room and staffing. Shared service (delivery and support) with Boston Borough Council and South Holland District Council.



MABLETHORPE & SUTTON TOWN COUNCIL

Cemeteries:	Trusthorpe cemetery; consecration; burials and interment of ashes; headstone permissions; grave reservations; exhumations; closed churchyard maintenance; keeper of burial records for Trusthorpe cemetery.
Environment:	Provision of dog/litter bins (partnership in action, TC provides bins, ELDC empty bins, LCC disposes waste); street furniture (seats/signs); siting of donated public seats; Railway Turntable conservation project.; Acre Gap; promote & support 'In Bloom' competitions. Verge grass cutting in place of LCC.
Leisure:	St Marys Conservation Area; Acre Gap; Railway Access Walk; Branch Line Walk; Cycleways (both in town and on promenade); some definitive footpaths; allotment gardens (Sutton & Trusthorpe); play equipment. Mablethorpe weekly market. Hosting/supporting local events.
Tourism:	Work with ELDC for summer/winter illuminations; promotion and publicity of parish events by partnership working; parish Christmas trees & lights; town hanging baskets and planters; theme signposts; production of bi-annual town guide.
Planning:	Consultees on all planning applications for parish; some licences and street collections; input into Local Development Framework; Right To Build proposals; lead in Neighbourhood development Orders and Town Plan
Property:	Mablethorpe Community Hall, Meridale Centre, Sutton on Sea; Public toilets (North End Mablethorpe, Coral Café Mablethorpe, Bohemia Way Sutton on Sea; Coral café building, storage: Quebec Road & Trusthorpe cemetery; Beach Huts (Mablethorpe) some bus shelters.
Other:	Remembrance Sunday parades and services; civic events and promotion; town asset management and ownership; CCTV ownership of cameras; war memorial maintenances; Information, advice and guidance to residents.
Grants:	Grant funding/equipment donations to community bodies; contributions towards swimming lessons for primary school; Citizens Advice Bureau.
	Working relationship with local constituted groups and receive resident's concerns and act where possible; Partnership working to provide & retain services, working with ELDC/LCC on shared services and asset transfers.
	Provide links to the principal councils to help provide public information point. Legislative body to authorise Freedom of the Town.
Consulted: on	Planning applications; phone box removal; listing of structures; drainage issues; street naming; parking restrictions; by laws; speed limits and road safety. Takes part as statutory body in consultations on sea defence work; refuse collection and disposal; winter salting routes and grit bins; policy matters affecting the area.
